OPERATIONAL AGREEMENT

This Operational Agreement stands as evidence the Oxnard Police Department and the Ventura County District Attorney's Office on behalf of the Crime Victims' Assistance Unit, Safe Harbor Multi-Disciplinary Interview Center and Ventura County Family Justice Center, intend to work together toward the mutual goal of providing maximum available assistance for crime victims residing in or seeking services in Ventura County. To this end, each program coordinates and provides the following services:

- The Oxnard Police Department will refer victims of crime to the Ventura County District Attorney's Crime Victims' Assistance Unit, Safe Harbor Multi-Disciplinary Interview Center and Ventura County Family Justice Center.
- The Ventura County District Attorney's Crime Victims' Assistance Unit, Safe Harbor Multi-Disciplinary Interview Center and Ventura County Family Justice Center will provide crime victims with crisis intervention, referrals for services, court support, Victims of Crime Compensation applications, restraining order services and accompaniment to law enforcement offices as requested by law enforcement.
- The Ventura County District Attorney's Crime Victims' Assistance Unit, Safe Harbor Multi-Disciplinary Interview Center and Ventura County Family Justice Center will provide community presentations, distribute information and outreach at storefronts and other locations, and provide program information to officers at briefings as requested by the agency.


